| 31. | <p><b>Viña Real Reserva, Rioja, CVNE 2013, Spain</b></p> <p>The winemaking here is ably controlled by Jesus Madrazo who shows a skilled touch, especially with this Reserva. The flavours are of ripe strawberry overlaid with typical vanilla oak from the 4 years in barrel. Floral and mature.</p>          | 13.5 | £38.50 |
| 32. | <p><b>Massaya Le Colombier, Bekaa Valley 2017, Lebanon</b></p> <p>Spicy notes with ripe, meaty, blackberry and red fruits, and a touch of chocolate. This supple, round wine is from an exciting French-Lebanese collaboration, which owns vineyards at an altitude of 1,000 metres in the Bekaa Valley.</p>   | 14.5 | £31.00 |
| 33. | <p><b>Cristóbal 1492 Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina</b></p> <p>A perfect combination of ripe red fruit character and spice, enhanced by subtle use of French oak barrels. The palate is rich, beefy and almost savoury with lovely length.</p>   | 13.5 | £27.00 |
| 34. | <p><b>House of Certain Views Shiraz, Margan Wines, Australia</b></p> <p>We can't be certain what views Andrew Margan gets from his house; hopefully they're as stunning as this wine. Black berry fruit meets smoky bacon and wait for those soft, silky tannins to kick in. Pure velvet and a great view!</p> | 13.5 | £28.00 |
| 35. | <p><b>Cousiño Macul Antiguas Reservas, Cabernet Sauvignon, Maipo, Chile</b></p> <p>Aged for one year in French oak with further ageing in bottle, the style here is quite classic having excellent ripe blackcurrant flavours with a good backbone.
